12th Article the ^{Town.} discounted to Constable Knight the Taxes due for the years 1823 for 1824 for the year 1825 against the Widd: Eunice Willis the sum of -- -- \$5.81

Also Samuel Gleason Taxes due for the year 1820 for 1821 for 1822 for 1823 for 1824. the sum of -- \$13.49

also Walter Hayner sons Poll Tax for the year 1824 -- 1.30

and also Lewis Moore sons Poll Tax for the year 1824 1.30

Total sum discounted 21.90

13th Article the Town voted to appropriate the sum of thirty five dollars for their Saldgers dinners and powder on Muster day and the Selectmen to draw their orders on the town Treasurer to the commanding officers of the respective companies their proportion of the money according to the number of men each company has that does duty on said muster day.

14th Voted to pass over this Article and ^{not} to act upon it

15th Article Voted to pass over this article

16th Article granted the sum of twenty dollars for the purpas of Purchasing School Books to be placed in the hands of the School Committee they to be accountable to the Town for the same

17th Article voted to appropriate the sum of five dollars eighty three cents for the purpas as expressed in the article and also voted to appropriate the sum of fifty dollars for the purpas as expressed in this article

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this Meeting
