town qualified by the Constitution to Vote for Representative in the General  
Court of said Commonwealth to Assemble at the Meeting house in said town  
on Monday the sixeth day of November next it being the first Monday  
of said month at one O'clock in the after noon to give in their Votes  
for a Representative of the People of said Commonwealth in the  
Congress of the United States for the Middlesex District

Hence of you are not to fail of making of this Warrant  
with your daings there on to the Selectmen previous to the  
time sett for opening said meeting.
