At a legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts
qualified by the Constitution to vote in the choice of Representatives
in the General Court. holden on the sixth day of November
being the first monday of said month in the year ^{of our Lord} one thousand
eight hundred and twenty six for the purpose of giving in their
votes for a Representative of said Commonwealth in the
Congress of the United States for the Middlesex District.
The whole number of votes given in were sorted counted and
a declaration thereof made and recorded as the said directs
And were for the following Persons (viz)

 { Hon. John Heyes one vote
