[Seal] You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to Notify and Warn all the freeholders and
other Inhabitants of the said Town of Sudbury qualified
by Law to Vote in town affairs to Assemble at the Meeting
House in said town on Monday the 6th day of November
next at 3 O'clock in the afternoon then and there to act
on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To Choose a Moderator - - - - -
- 2^d To See if the Town will Choose an agent or agents to attend
the Commissioners of Highways for the County of Middlesex
on the Petition of Joseph Davis and others for a Strating or
alteration of the road from Northborough line through the
South part of this town to Watertown - And also on the Petition
of Joel Cranston on others for an alteration or Strating of the
road from Marlborough Poor house establishment through
the center of this town to Weston Meeting house to do or act any
way on this article as the town shall think best when meet.
- 3^d To See if the town will grant a sum of money to make the necessary repairs
to the Highways to do or act any way on this article as they shall
think best.
- 4th To See if the Town will except of a ~~road~~ Bridle way laid out by the
Selectmen through the land of Mr. Joel Jones to the County road
for the benefit of David Howe and others. - - - - -
- 5th To See if the Town will except of a road as laid out by the Selectmen
from Lankum road so called to land of William Hurd
- 6th To See if the town will take any measures for the purpose of
repairing Shermans bridge or rebuilding the same - And also
the bridge near the house of the late Daniel Orsborn Deceased
- 7th To See if the Town will Choose a Pound keeper to fill the Vacancy
in that office.
- 8th To hear reports of Committees if any reports are offered
- 9th To See if the town will take any measures for the purpose of prosecuting
the town of Watertown or Needham for the support of the family
of the late Frances Whitney to do or act any way on this article
as the town shall think best.
