the whole line being about ten rods this being the front the whole
body of tombs must lay on the northerly of said line
your committee further state that as very few of the Petitioners
were present at their meeting no uniform plan could well
be fixed but as it is expected that a considerable number of
tombs will be built your committee do recommend that the town
give leave to the builders to fix on some uniform plan to
suit themselves, all which is respectfully Submitted by your
Committee ——— Isaac Gibbs Chairman

9th Article. The town voted that the Selectmen be directed to
commence a Sute either against the Town of Watertown or
Heddenham for the support of the late Francis Whittrick same-
ly as that they should think most advisable and the best
interest to the town and carry it to final judgment
