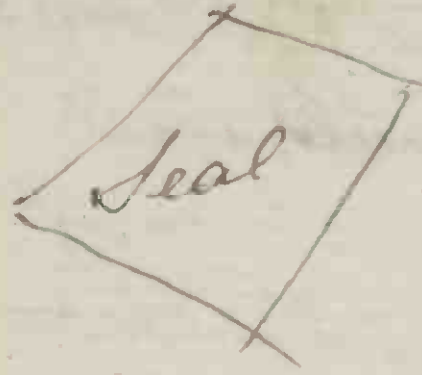

of Sudbury in said County

Greeting

 You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to Notify and Warn all the Inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified by Law to vote in Town
affairs to meet and assemble at the Meeting house in said
town on Monday the 15th day of January current at one
of the O'clock in the after noon on said day then and there
to act on the following Articles (viz)

1st To choose a Moderator

2^d Article, To see if the Town will give ~~liberty~~ the Selectmen
any directions if any what respecting their giving
Mr. William Hunt or his half yearly order which
was due the 15th day of September last past according
to the contract made by the Selectmen some time since
respecting his keeping the Poor of said town which
the Selectmen will make the town fully acquainted with
at the time and place of said Meeting

3 Article, To see if town will take any measures if any what
respecting Building a pauper house establishment by
request Capt Israel Haynes and Mr. Martin Brown

4th Article, To see if the town will paint the Meeting house
it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Asa Hays

Them of you are not to fail of making a return of
this warrant with your doings there on to some one
of the Selectmen previous to the opening of said meeting
