And granted the sum of one thousand Dollars for that purpose
and voted that the price of Labour for Man, Oxen, and Cart
to be the same as was the last year.

3^d Article. Voted not to give liberty for Swine, Horses, Mules,
neats, Cattle, and Sheep to go at large the present year

4th Article. Voted to Adopt the same Measures in regard
to collecting the Taxes as was the last year

5th Article. Voted to except of the reports of the Ministerial
fund corporation, also the report of the Annual Bridge
Committee, and the School House Committee, which are
here recorded (viz)

Agreeable to an Act of the Legislature of this Commonwealth
of Massachusetts passed June the 14th 1817. Establishing
a Ministerial fund in the town of Sudbury making it duty
of the trustees thereof to make Report to said town the state of
said fund and their doings thereon at the annual Meeting in the month
of March or April agreeable to said act said trustees ask leave to report
as follows (viz)
