7th Article. The town voted to discontinue Mr Loring Eatons Highway Taxes in future during the Towns pleasure

8th Article. The town voted, that the several school houses in said town may be accopied for Religious meetings, provided that no damage be done to said houses and Schoolers Books in the mean time
