

April Anno Domini 1827.

At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 2^d day of April AD 1827. proceeded upon the business of said day and took up the 1st Article and made choice of Mr. John Hunt Moderator

2^d Article. brot in their votes for a county Treasurer and after sorting and counting said votes it appeared that the Hon. John Keyes had the number of fifty nine votes Mr. John Hunt one vote.

3^d Article. brot in their votes for a town Treasurer and and the whole number of votes given in were seventy six and Mr. John Hunt. had the number of forty four votes and is chosen. After Goodman Esq. had thirty two votes

Then voted to take the same Measures for the purpos of collecting the Taxes that may be Assessed upon the Inhabitants of said town the present year, as was adapted the last year Then Mr. Martin Brown come forward and offered to take the collecting of the Taxes the present year, for two per cent on the Dollar. And it being put to vote, it passed in the negative,

Then Mr. Shaddocks Tower offered to take the collecting of the Taxes the present year, for one and a quarter per cent on the Dollar provided he could have the constables bearth that being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. And then brot in their votes for a constable. And Mr. Shaddocks Tower was unanimously chosen constable and collector of Taxes. for the present year. Mr. Hull Goodnow who was chosen one of the school committee at the last March meeting come forward and declined serving in that office the present year Then the town proceeded and made choice of Capt. Henry Richardson in sted of Mr. Goodnow. Then Mr. John Haynes come forward and asked to be excused from serving as one of the Highway Surveyors for the north east ward the present year and the town by their vote excused Mr. Haynes from serving in that office Then proceeded and made choice of Mr. Hakim Thompson to fill that vacancy. Then Mr. Thompson asked to be excused from serving and the town excused Mr. Thompson, from serving And chose Capt Israel Haynes then Capt. Haynes excused himself from serving. And then choose Mr. John Hunt, to fill the vacancy of Highway Surveyors in the A & B District

4th Article. Voted to except of the Settlement of the selectmen with the Town Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded. which is here after recorded as follows
