The Town being meet agreeable to the aforesaid adjournment and proceeded upon the unfinished business of said Meeting and took up the 6th article and passed it over for the present and took up the 7th Article and Discounted to Constable Brown the following Taxes (viz)

Then proceeded and took up the 2^d Article and proceeded and choose two ~~School~~ Committee men in addition to be joined with the one extra one chosen at March Meeting (viz) (the Rev^d Rufus Hurlbut) so as to comply with the new school act. and the following Gentlemen were chosen by Ballot (viz) Dr Thomas Sterns Asher Goodnow Esq. Then proceeded and took up the 6th Article, and attended to the report of the Meeting house Committee and after the Committee had explained upon said report and some discussion being had upon the subject matter of said report. It was moved and seconded to see if the Town would make any repairs to the Meeting house, it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. Then it was moved and seconded to see if the Town would take of the Ruoff of said Meeting house and put on a new one, it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative eighty two voted for it, and thirty six against it. Then it was moved and seconded, to see if the Town would take down the steeple to the Meeting house, and put on a cupola in its stead. and make a new front on wings to the Tower and ^{all} new Pews that can conveniently be made on the ground of the body seats and in the gallery, it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. Eighty voting for it, and thirty three against it.

Then it was moved and seconded to see if the Town would choose a Committee to superintend the making said repairs, it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. Said Committee to be chosen by ballot. one from each School District the votes being called for and counted it appeared that Capt. Tilly Smith, Asher Goodnow Esq. Mr. Paul Walker, Mr. Reuben Haynes, Mr. Levi Smith were chosen for that purpose. Then voted that the further consideration of this subject be put over to next meeting. then voted to discontinue this meeting. John Hurst, Moderator
