Middlesex Co. To Mr. Thaddeus Tower Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County

Greeting
you are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male Inhabitants of said town of Sudbury, qualified as the law directs to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said town on Monday the 16th day of April current at 3 o'clock in the afternoon of said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

1st To choose a Moderator

2^d To see if the Town will order their Selectmen to give William Hunt for his town order which is due him for keeping the Poor on the 15th day of September last past agreeable to contract made with the said Hunt for keeping the Poor of said town. And to take some Measures to prosecute said Hunt for a breach of contract if any there be to do, or act any way on this Article, it being agreeable to the request of Mr. John Hunt and others -

3^d To see if the will choose an agent to attend the Court of Sessions at Concord which is to be holden on the 2^d Tuesday of May next to oppose the execution of a ~~new~~ private way as laid out by the Selectmen over the land of Joel Jones and reported to the town on the 6 day of November last past by the Selectmen of said town upon the petition of David Howe and others, reference to an of notice to an order of notice served on the town clerk by order of said Court of Sessions, being had.

Hence of you are not to fail of making your return of this Warrant with your doings there on to to some one of the Selectmen previous to the opening of said meeting.
