prosecuting said Hunt if he will deduct twenty five dollars
of the expense of a law suite about the Gibbs girl out of his
order and to receive no interest by his not having his order
at the time it was due, and the town not to charge interest
on a note he gave the Town Treasurer - some time since

votes for a Representative to Represent them in the
General Court to be convened at Boston on the last
Wednesday of May next.
