At a legal Town Meeting legally held in Sudbury on Monday the 7th day of May 1827
proceeded upon the business of said day pursuant to the Constitution of this Commonwealth
And on motion being made to see if the town will send a representative and it
passed in the affirmative then proceeded and wrote in their votes for
one Representative and after the votes being counted and sorted it
appeared that Abel Wheeler had the number of one hundred votes
And was chosen Ascher Goodnow had 15 votes
John Hurst - - - - - 3 votes
Cal Fairbanks had - - - - - 2 votes

- 3^d To grant money to pay the accounts that are by the Committee
on accounts. allowed
- 4th To grant the Reverend Rufus Hurlbut his salary.
- 5th To grant money for the support of the Grammar Schools. and
School Books, and wood for said Schools - -
- 6 To grant money for the reading and writing Schools
- 7th To grant money to pay the Assessors and the Town Treasurer
the year ensuing -
