- 8th To grant money for the support of the poor of said town for the year ensuing.
- 9th To act on the 5th Article in the warrant of April meeting containing the 5th Article of November meeting and referred to May meeting for further consideration.
- 10th To see if the Town will choos an agent ~~into~~ appear at the Court of Sessions to be holden at Concord on the 2^d Tuesday of May next to oppose a road petitioned for by David Howe and others over the land of Joel Jones it being agreeable to the request of Joel Jones—
- 11 To see if town will direct their selectmen to les the John Green Farme the present year to do. or act any way on this article—
- 12th To see if the town will appoint some suitable persons to take care of and sweep the Meeting house and ^{dig} Graves as occasion may require for the year ensuing—
- 13th To see if the town appropriate any unappropriated ^{money} in the Treasurers not other wise appropriated to pay the soldiers a dinner who do duty on muster ^{day} to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think best when met

None of you are not to fail of making a return of this warrant with your doings there on to some one of the Selectmen previous to the opening of this meeting.
