Sudbury May 21<sup>st</sup> AD 1827.

The Town being meet agreeable to the foregoing adjournment Proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 4<sup>th</sup> Article in the Warrant of said meeting and granted to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Rufus Hurlbut for his Salary in addition to the Interest arising to from the Ministerial fund the sum of \$ 457.95

5<sup>th</sup> Article, granted for the support of the Grammar Schools the sum of - - - 375.00  
to be equally divided among the five districts

Also granted for wood for said Schools - - - 45.00

6<sup>th</sup> Article, granted for the reading and writing Schools to be equally divided the sum of - - - 200.00

7<sup>th</sup> Article, granted to pay the Assessors - - - 20.00  
and the Town Treasurers - - - 10.00

8<sup>th</sup> granted for the support of the Poor - - - 1000.00

9<sup>th</sup> Article Voted to pass over this Article to the next town Meeting - - -

10 Article postponed this Article indefinitely

Then the Town Voted to take up the 2<sup>d</sup> Article. And on a motion being made and seconded to see if the Town would reconsider the vote passed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May Instant so far as respects taking down the Steeple and putting on a cupola building wings to the Tower. which was Voted to be made at the Town meeting holden on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April last past and reconsidered at the meeting holden on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May Instant. so as leave the vote stand as it was Voted the 16<sup>th</sup> day April aforesaid. the question being put to vote, it passed in the affirmative. 78 Voting for it, 9 against it. Then the Town Voted to choose a Committee for the purpose of considering what Instructions to give the Committee which was chosen on the 16<sup>th</sup> of April last past for the purpose of making the repairs to the Meetinghouse said Committee to consist of three and the following Persons was chosen (viz) Capt. Israel Haynes, Abel Wheeler, and Asaph Goodnow Esq. then Asaph Goodnow Esq excused him self and chose Mr. Samuel Jones in his stead. And after said Committee had retired for a few minutes they returned made the following report which was accepted and ordered it to be recorded as follows
