That they be instructed to make the repairs that the Town has voted to make, to procure all the materials that will be necessary for repairs and to commence their work on said house by the middle of May next either to hire a Man to Superintend the work or to let out any part, or the whole, as the Committee shall think it will be most for the Interest to the Town, And to sell all the new Pews And ruffage stuff that is not wanted about said repairs And the proceeds of the sale of Pews and ruffage stuff to be applied towards the expense of making said repairs if needed. and said Committee to account to the town for the sale of Pews and ruffage stuff and the expense of repairs after work shall have been completed.
