The Town voted to grant the sum of 135..14
to pay the accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts

11th Voted that the Selectmen be directed to lease the John
Green Farm to said Green as they should ^{think} proper

12th Article Voted that the Selectmen be directed to let
out the taking care of the meeting house sweeping the
same ringing the bell and digging graves as occasions
may require

13th Article. It was moved and seconded to appropriate the
sum of twenty five dollars out of any unappropriated
money now in the Treasury to pay the expense of
the Soldiers a dinner on Muster day who do duty
on that day.

Then the town voted that the several sums of money
granted by the town to be made into a rate and assessed
upon the Polls and estates agreeable to ^{the} Laws of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts

Then the town by their vote dissolved this meeting
