You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts to notify and warn all the freeholders and other Inhabitants of the
Town of Sudbury to meet at the Meeting house in said town on Monday the 15th
day of October Instant at 1 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there
to act on the following articles. (viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator.
- 2^d To See if the Town will commence an action against the Town of Southborough
for the support of the Wido. Theodore Clarke now residing in the town of
Sudbury and to choose an agent or agents, to prosecute and defend the same
to final judgement to do, or act any way on this article as the town shall
think best when meet.
- 3^d To See if the Town take any Measures for the purpose of rebuilding
or repairing their proportion of Shermans Bridge and to choose
a Committee to carry the same into effect to do, or act &c.
- 4th To See if the Town will take any measures for the purpose of selling
any part of the John Green farm or fencing the same to do, or act &c.
- 5th To fill the Vacancy in the School Committee occasioned by the
removal of Capt. Henry Richardson in the Southeast District

with your doings there on to some one of the Selectmen pre-
=ous to the opening of said meeting.
