

October Anno Domini 1827.

At a legal Town meeting held by the Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury on Monday the 15th day of October A.D. 1827.

Proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of Mr. John Hunt Moderator

2^d Article, a motion was made and seconded to see if the town would commence a suit against the town of Southborough for the support of the Widow Sheredone Clark and it passed in the affirmative, then Voted to choose three agents and chose the Selectmen (viz) Samuel Knight, Drury Fairbank, and Warren Howe to prosecute the Town of Southborough as expressed in said Article

3^d Article Voted to choose a committee of three persons for the purpose of expressed in said article and made choice of Asaph Goodnow Esq then Asaph Goodnow Esq was excused from serving then chose Abel Wheeler, Paul Walker, and Reuben Haynes with power to repair or rebuild said Bridge as they should think best for the town interest.

4th Article. Voted to direct the Selectmen to sell a part of the John Green farm all that part South of the road to the best advantage to the town with power to pass Orders.

6th Article, Voted to choose a school committee men in the South east district in the name of Capt Richardson and Voted to choose by nomination and made choice of Mr. Samuel Knight in his stead.

Then the town by their vote dissolve the meeting
