You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
to notify and warn all the male Inhabitants of said Town
qualified by Law to vote in the choice of Town Officers and town affairs
to meet at the Meeting house in said Town on Monday the 3^d day of
March next at 12 O'clock at noon on said day then and there
to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurer
Assessors, Constable, School Committee And all other Town officers
that are by Law required to be chosen in the month of March
or April.
- 2^d To see if the Town will repair their Highways by a rate the
present year and grant a suitable sum of money for repair-
ing the same
- 3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine, Horses, Mules,
cats, cattle and sheep to go at large the present year.
- 4th To see if the Town will take the same measures for the purposes
of collecting their Taxes that may be Assessed upon the Inhabi-
tants of said Town as was adapted the year past. And to give
with some suitable person or persons to collect the same for the
year to do or act as the Town shall think best when met.
- 5th To hear and except of the report of the Trustees of the Sudbury
Ministerial fund corporation.
- 6th To see if Town will choose a Committee to examine and allow
accounts that may be brot in against said Town.
- 7th To see if the Town will except of a road as laid out by the
Selectmen from William Thurd land over the land of Elisha Thunt
to Lankum road so called
- 8th To see if the town will direct their Assessors to take the Invoice
of the taxable property in said town the present year. By request
of Capt. Tully Haynes.
- 9th To attend to reports of committees if any reports are made
- 10th To see if the town will take any measures for the purpose of
opening the road lately located by the Court of Sessions from
County road near brimston lane so called over the land
of Joel Jones, to David Howe House -
