3^d Article passed in the Negative

9th Article. the Selectmen made a report as follows (viz)

your committee appointed October last for the purpose of selling a part of the John Green Farm have attended to that service and leave to report as follows viz sold to Capt William Bingham at Public Auction the lot on the south side of the road called five acres be the same more or less for twenty eight Dollars and fifty cents and taken said Bingham note on interest with a signer.
