=monwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn the Inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections to meet
at the meeting house in Sudbury on Monday the seventh
day of April at one O'clock in the afternoon being the first
monday of said month.

To bring in their Votes to the Selectmen for Governor
and Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth and for
five Senators on one ballot for the district of Middlesex
for the year ensuing.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting
an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting house in said
Town two Sabbath at least before the time for holding said
Meeting --

If you fail not and make due return of this warrant
with your doings there on to our selves at the time and place holding
of Meeting.
