Middlesex Co. To Thaddeus Tower Constable of the Town of
Sudbury in said County

Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the meeting house in said town on Monday the 7th day of April next at three o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To chace a Moderator ~
- 2^d To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer for the year ensuing for the County of Middlesex
- 3^d To fill all the Vacancies in those Town officers with the law requires to be chosen it being a part of the 1st Article of March Meeting and put over to April meeting
- 4th To act upon the 4th 5th 6th 7th 8th and 11th Articles in the warning of March Meeting and referred to April meeting for further consideration ~
- 5th To see if the town will grant a suitable sum of money for the support of the several schools in said town for the year ensuing agreeable to the late Law of the Commonwealth
- 7th To see if the town will except of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the town Treasurer and order the same to be reconciled
- 8th To bring in their votes by Ballot yea or Nay in order to ascertain the minds of the town whether they will consent that the several towns in the north westerly part of the County of Middlesex shall be sett of to the north part of the County of Worcester for the purpose of forming a new County
- 9th To see if the town will give liberty for the northeast District to expend the remaining part of their grammar school money in a women school in said District

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy thereof at the public meeting house in said town two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting

There of fail not and make due return of this warrant with your obings there on to our selves at the time and place of meeting upon said Given under our hands and Seal this 17th day of March AD 1828.
