Middlesex Co. Sudbury April 7th 1828. Pursuant to the writ in warrant
I have summoned and notified the Inhabitants of said town qualified
as those in expressed to assemble at the time and place and for the
purposes within mentioned
Chaaddeus Tower Constable

At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 7th day of
April AD 1828. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking
up the 1st Article and made choice of John Hunt Moderator
2^d Article brot in their vote for a County Treasurer and after sorting
and counting said votes and were for the following Persons (v's)
Hon. Hon. John Freys forty seven votes.
" Benjamin F. Varnum two votes
" Luke Dist. one vote
3^d Article brot in their votes for a town Treasurer and made
choice of Mr John Hunt. Then voted to pass over this article
for the present and took up the 4th Article containing the 4th
Article of March meeting referred to April meeting And
voted to adopt the same measures as it regards the collecting
of Taxes as was adopted the last year for the present year
Then Mr Christopher F. Cutler came forward and offered to the
collecting of Taxes for one and half cent on the Dollar and the town excepted
of his proposals. Then the town voted to take up the 3^d Article and made
choice of Christopher F. Cutler for their Constable and collector of Taxes
Then the town voted to choose a School Committee consisting of five Persons
one in each School District and the following Persons were chosen (v's)
Chaaddeus Tower, Josiah Haynes, Enoch Widdler, David Hoar, and
Hilzon Barrell to Superintend and provide for the several Schools
in said town. Then voted to grant the sum of ----- \$ 375.00
Dollars for the support of Grammar Schools to be equally divided in
the five School Districts, then granted the sum of ----- 45.00
for wood to be equally divided in said district Then voted to grant
money for the reading and writing schools & granted the sum of 200.00
for that purpose and ordered the same to be equally divided in said Districts
Then took up the 4th Article containing the 5th Article in the warrant of
March Meeting which was referred to April meeting. The Trustees of the Sudbury
Ministerial fund Corporation made a report of the state of the funds
which is hereafter recorded (v's)
