

April Anno Domini 1828~

The town being meet according to the foregoing adjournment and proceeded upon the unfinished business of meeting by taking up the 7th Article in the warrant of March meeting returned to April meeting then it was moved and seconded to see if the town would except of the report of the Selectmen the laying out William Hurds road and the conditions upon which it was laid out and it passed in the affirmative for boundaries see recorded in the old Books of records of roads
 8th Article returned from March to April meeting The town voted to direct their Assessors to goe round and take the taxable property of the Inhabitants what they are possessed of on the first day of May to be done on or before the tenth day of May next
 11th Article returned from March to April meeting passed in the negative.

7th Article in April Meeting the Selectmen made a report of the Settlement of ~~the~~ with the town Treasurer and was excepted and ordered the same to be recorded which is as follows (viz)

We the subscribers having settled accounts with Mr John Hunt Treasurer for the town of Sudbury find the state of the Treasurer as follows (viz)

Also now in the Treasurer the sum of \$ 8..00 paid in by Abel Wheeler for the purpos of purchasing Book for those children that are not able to pay for the same.
