

April Anno Domini 1828.

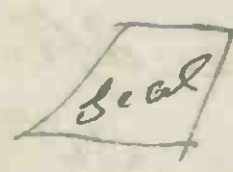
8th Article passed over for the present and took up the 9th Article. after some time being spent in discussing upon the subject matter then voted to pass over this article and not to act upon it.

Then took up the 8th Article and brot in their ballots yea or nay upon the Subject of a new County being formed out of a part of the Counties of Worcester and Middlesex after the Selectmen had sorted and counted the votes it appeared that there was forty three nays and one yea Then took up the 1st Article and Josiah Haynes came forward and desired to be excused from serving on the School Committee the present year and the town excused him then made chairs of Mr John Jones in his stead

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this meeting

To bring in their votes to the Selectmen for a Representative to represent them in the General Court to be convened and holden at Boston on the last Wednesday of May next

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy thereof at the public Meeting house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting

Given of full rat and make due returne of this warrant with your doings there on to our selves at time and place of holding meeting as afore said. Given under our hands and Seal this 21 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight
