- 11th To see if town will take any measures respecting the land that is inclosed on lake end hill so called and the land that Walter Haynes has inclosed neare the towns pound that belongs to the town to do or act any way on this Article as the town shall think best when meet it being by request of John Hunt-
- 12th To see if ~~the~~ will discount to Thaddeus Tower and Martin Brown cartin Taxes which they shall offer to be discounted
- 13th To see if town grant money to pay Elisha Hunt for land taken for a road for the accomodation of Willeam Hurd
- 14th To see if the town will otherwise thier meeting house committer to agree with Luther Goodnow & Benjamin Dudley for thier Pews which be necessary in order to repair the meeting house as your Committee are directed to do or act any way ^{as this} article as the town shall think best when meet

And you are directed to serve this warrant by Posting up attested copy thereof at the Public meeting house in said town two Sabbathes at least before the time for holding said meeting~

There of fail not and make due returne of this warrant with your doings there on to ourselves at the time and place of meeting afore said.
