- 5th granted to pay the Assessors the present year the sum of - - - 20..00
and to pay the Town Treasurer the present year the sum of - - - 10..00
- 6th Voted that the Selectmen be directed let out the taking care of the meeting house as expressed in said Article -
- 7th no reports were offered
- 8th Voted to appropriate any unappropriated money now or may be in the Treas^r not other wise appropriated for the purpose as expressed in said Article
- 9th Voted to except of a list of jurors ^{the sum of thirty five Dollars} as made out and laid before the town by their Selectmen -
- 10th Voted that the Selectmen be directed to take care of the property of the late Jonathon Clarke if any there be belonging to the town
- 11th Voted to pass over this Article and not act upon it
- 12th Voted to discount to Martin Brown Lartin Taxes to him committed to collect for the year 1826 (viz) Extra large Tax the sum of \$ 3..04

- 14th The town Voted that the meeting house committee ^{be} authorized to agree with Luther Goodnow & Benjamin Buckley for their Pews if they can on reasonable terms or otherwise to have them appraised as the Law in such case has made and provided, to be left with the committee to do as they shall think will be most to ^{the} interest of the town
- 2^d Then Voted to take up the 2^d Article and the committee on accounts brot forward there allowance of accounts exhibited which amounted to the sum of twenty one Dollars & sixty the cents ^{have} after recorded on the other side of this leaf.
