- 4th To see if the town will give liberty for swine, Horses, Mules, neat cattle, and sheeps to go at large the present year
- 5th To see if the town will take the same measures for the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said town as was adapted the year past. And agree with some suitable person or persons to elect the same for the year ensuing to do, or act as the town shall think best when meet.
- 6th To hear and except the report of the Ministerial fund exploration
- 7th To see if the town will chuse a committee to examine and allow all accounts that may be brot in against the town
- 8th To attend to all reports of committees if any reports are made
- 9th To Act on the 4th Article ^{in the} warrant of Saurin meeting which was referred to March meeting for further consideration
- 10th To see if the town will take any measures for the purpose of providing for a Poore establishment in said town whereby the poore may be rendered less expensive in future to do, or act, any way on this article as the town shall think best when meet.
- 11th To see if the town will discount to the collectors certain Taxes which they may offer to be discounted.
- 12th To see if the town will appropriate any unappropriated money to take up out standing orders and pay any other demands.
- 13th To see if the town will except of of a road if laid out by the selectmen from the old road leading by Mr. Daniel Bowers and through said Bowers land and land of Mr Asa Balcoms to the old road leading by Eben r. Stwarts.
- 14th To see if the town will take any measures for the purpose of exchanging the new Bell on the meeting house to do, or act any way on this article as the town shall think best when meet.
