

April Anno Domini 1829-

At a Town meeting legally held in Sudbury on Monday the 6th day of April AD 1829. it being the first Monday of said month, proceeded upon the business of said day by bringing in their Votes to the Selectmen for Governor, Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth, and for five Senators for the Middlesex District - as by the Constitution is directed and were for the following Persons -

For Governor, His Excellency Levi Lincoln seventy seven Votes
Thomas L. Winthrop one Vote

For Lieutenant Governor, His Honour Thomas L. Winthrop fifty seven Votes

For Senators
Hon. Benjamin F. Varnum seventy seven Votes
Hon. Leonard M. Parker fifteen Votes
Hon. Charles Train three Votes
Hon. James Lewis sixty six Votes
Nathan Chapman forty one Votes
Augustus Towner forty two Votes
M. M. Rutter forty one Votes
John Lewis six Votes
Hon. John Fryer five Votes
Hon. Luke Fiske five Votes
Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this meeting
