You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn the male Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Meeting-house in said town on Monday the 6th day of April next at three O'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following Articles viz

- 1st To Chas a Moderator
- 2^d To fill Vacancies in town officers that shall appear to be Vacant
- 3^d To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer for the County of Middlesex
- 4th To attend to the report of the meeting house Committee and take such order there on as shall be thought proper to adjust ~~the~~ and settle the same if said report be made
- 5th To see if the town will except of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the town Treasurer
- 6th To attend to the report of the ~~Meeting~~ house Committee and take such order there on as the town shall think best when met
- 7th To act on the 5th Article in the warrant of March meeting which was referred to April meeting
- 8th To act on the 9th 11th and 13th Articles of in the warrant which was referred to April meeting for consideration
- 9th To discount to the collectors of Taxes, such Taxes as they shall offer to be discounted
- 10th To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to get a copy of the items of expenses for repairing the meeting-house the past year - and to print one hundred copies for the use of the town - Also to print one hundred copy of the items of the the ordinary expenses of the past year to do. or act as the town shall think best when met. by request of Dea. Doherty and others.
