

April Anno Domini 1829.

At a legal Town meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Litchfield held on Monday the 6th day of April AD 1829

proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of Mr. John Hunt Moderator

2^d Article. Then proceeded to fill the vacancy in town officer as follows viz Capt. Lyman Howe being chosen one of the selectmen at the March meeting came forward and asked to be excused from serving as one of the selectmen the present year it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. then made choice of Mr. Christopher G. Luntz in his stead. Mr. Luntz's Moore came forward and asked to be excused from serving as one of the Assessors the present year it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative then made choice of Abel Wheeler in his stead.

then made choice of Mr. John Hunt Town Treasurer

Then passed over the remaining part of this Article and took up the 7th Article containing the 5th Article of March meeting which was referred to April meeting And voted to adopt the same measures in regard to the collecting the Taxes the present year as was adopted the last year viz voted to give one and a half cents on the dollar for collecting the Taxes that may be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said town the ensuing year. Then the town took up the 2^d Article again and made choice of Christopher G. Luntz Constable & Collector of Taxes the present year.

3^d Article Brought in their votes for a County Treasurer and after counting and sorting the votes it appeared that there were for Hon. John Keyes fifty three votes, John Green one vote

4th Article. the meeting house committee presented their report and after said report having been read a motion was made & seconded ^{excepting of} upon the said report to May meeting and to appoint a committee of five one to each School District to examine in the time of said account and report the same at the next May meeting. the motion being put to vote it passed in the affirmative then the town made choice of the following Persons for a committee for the purpose as aforesaid (viz)

Capt. Enock Wheeler. Mr. Schun Thompson. Capt. William Brigham. Mr. Adam Howe. Mr. Daniel Puffer
