5th Article the Settlement of the selectmen with the Town Treasurer was presented read and accepted and ordered the same to be recorded as follows

the subscriber having settled accounts with Mr John Hunt for the Town of Sudbury and find the State of the Treas: as follows

(viz) The town grants for the year 1828 Amount to	\$ 2139 58
Also for the repair of the meeting house - - - - -	1000 00
Also for surplus arising from fractional Division in making the Taxes in said year - - - - -	132 29
Also to pay for collecting the Taxes for said year - - - - -	49 41
Total of the grants in said year 1828 - - - - -	3321 28
Which sum the Treasurer has since paid - - - - -	\$ 2844 67
Remains due the town on said grants - - - - -	476 61

Also remains due on the Settlement of the grant in the year 1827 the sum of - - - - - 3 22

David Trull Note the sum of 48.23

Eli Gates note the sum of - 9.10
