Nicholas Jr. To Christopher G. Luther Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County *greeting*

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you
are hereby directed to notify and warn all the male inhabitants
of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town officers
And also all such others of said inhabitants as are qualified
to vote in Parish affairs to meet at the meeting house
in said town on Monday the 4th day of May next at two
O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there to act
on the following Articles viz

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To grant the Reverend Rufus Threlkeld his salary the
the present year in addition to the interest arising from
Ministerial fund.
- 3^d To attend to the report of the Meeting house committee and
the subd committee which was appointed to examine the
items of said Meeting house committee account of the
expense of repairing the meeting house the past year
And to grant a suitable sum of money to finish paying
for said repairs.
- 4th To grant money for the support of the Poor
- 5th To grant money to pay the Assessors the present year
- 6th To grant money to pay the town Treasurer the present year
- 7th To grant money to pay the accounts that are allowed by the
committee on accounts
- 8th To act on the 6th Article in the warrant of April meeting
and referred to May meeting for further consideration
- 9th To act on the 11th and 12th Articles in the warrant of
April meeting and referred to May meeting for further
consideration.
- 10th To see if the town will ^{grant} the sum of one hundred Dollars
to be layed out in lowering the head on the top of green
hill the present year to do on act any way on this article
as the town shall think best when meet
- 11th To see if the town will exchange the pauper Pews for one
in the town to do on act any way as they shall think best
when meet.
