- 12th To see if they will appropriate the proceeds of the sale of the Pews if any are sold for the purpose of paying the expense of repairing the meeting house to do or act any way on this article
- 13th To see if the town will grant money for a singing school and choose a committee to lay out the same
- 14th To see if the town will grant a suitable sum of money to make the road layed out and executed by the town at the last November meeting over the land of Joel Jones and others to land of David Hower to do or act any way on this Article as the town shall think best when meet
- 15th To see if the town will choose an agent to attend the county commissioners at their next meeting to be holden at Concord on the second Tuesday of May next to oppose the Petition of Joel Jones reference to said Petition being had
- 16th To see if the town will order their Assessors to go and take all the taxable property of the inhabitants of said town and put every Person under oath that they suspect that does not give in correctly
- 17th To see if the town will appropriate any unappropriated money now in the Treasurers hands not other wise appropriated to pay the Soldier a dinner who do duty on muster day the present year to do or act

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy of this warrant at the public meeting house in said town two Sabbath at least before the time for holding said Meeting.
