Sudbury April 25th 1829

your committee to whom was referred the examination of the the items of accounts of the meeting house committee have attended that service and ask leave to report as follows. That they did think them selves ^{legally} authorized to get copies of their accounts printed but have examined their items of accounts and are satisfied with the correctness of the same - The committee held themselves ready individually to answer to any questions that may be asked relative to their accounts. Also they have examined the ordinary expense of the town past year and find them as follows (viz)
