You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts ^{meeting} to notify and warn all male inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs — And also all such of said inhabitants as are qualified to vote in Parish affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said town on Monday the 7th day of September next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon of said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To act on the 9th Article in the warrant of May meeting containing the 11th Article of April meeting which was referred to this meeting for further consideration
- 3^d To act on the 3^d 11th and 12th Articles in the warrant of May meeting which was referred to this meeting for further consideration
- 4th To act on 8th Article in the warrant of May meeting containing the 6th article of April meeting for further consideration
- 5th To see if the town will grant a suitable sum of money to defray the expense of the singing school.
- 6th To see if the town will grant money for the purpose of trimming the Pulpit
- 7th To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to settle the Bill that the Town of Orange has against this town for the support of Abel Eaton or stand a suit in law, to do, or act, any way as the ^{town} shall think best when meet
- 8th To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to defend a show cause that the town of East Sudbury has brought against this town for the support of Levi Maynard and family —
- 9th To see if the town will order William Maynard to make the necessary repairs to coach bridge to do or act any way on this as the town shall think best when meet
- 10th To see if the town will erect a road or a straightening of a road as laid out by the Selectmen near Mr. Moses Harmons. And give liberty for the Highway Surveyor to expend as much money on said road as wool be needed on the old road

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy of this warrant at the Public meeting house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

There of fail not and make ^{due} return of this warrant with your doing, there on to our clerks at time and place for holding said meeting
