

September Anno Domini 1829

At a legal Town meeting held in Sudbury the 7th day of September
AD 1829. Proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the

1st Article and made choice of Mr. John Hunt Moderator

2^d Article. It was moved and seconded to see if they would sell
any more Pews in the meeting house and it passed in the affirmative
then voted to sell the two back Pews on the west side of the Pulpit on
the floor of said house the same Committee who sold the last pews in
said house and authorized the same Person to give Deeds thereof

3^d Article. The 1st section thereof was passed over for the present
and took up the 11th Article of May meeting it being the 2^d section of this 3^d Article
a motion was made and seconded to pass over this article and passed in
the negative. Then a motion was made and seconded to see if they
would give the same Committee power who are authorized to sell
the two pews to exchange off the Pulpit pews one or more of them
for ~~the~~ Pews in the tower of said house

Then voted to pass over the 12 Article in said 3^d Article not to action it

4th Article after some time being spent in discussing this article
and a motion was made to see if the town would purchase a poor
establishment it being put to vote it passed in the negative

5th Article a motion was made to grant thirty Dollars it was negatived
then a motion was made to grant twenty Dollars and that was negatived
then a motion was made to grant fifteen Dollars and it passed in the
affirmative and granted the sum of ——— \$ 15—

6th Article The town voted to trim the Pulpit by getting a Lutter to
the window and appointed the same Committee which are
authorized to sell the Pews to purchase said Lutter and bring in
their account for the expence thereof

7th Article The town voted that the Selectmen be authorized to defend
a law suite if brot by the town of Orange against the town of
Sudbury for the support of Abel Eaton to final judgement

8th The town voted that the Selectmen be authorized as agents
to defend the law suite brot by the town of East Sudbury
against the town of Sudbury for the support of Levi Maynard
and formally to final judgement

9th Article voted that the Committee who had the superintendence
of repairing wash bridge and letting out the same
To call on Wm. Maynard repair said bridge forth with according to
the contract on see it is done immediately

10th Article voted to except of the road as repaired by the Selectmen
and the surveyor to expend as much money on said road as would take
to repair the old road. then voted to take up the 3^d Article again and
voted to put the further consideration of it to March meeting
then voted to dissolve this meeting
