achusetts to Notify and warn all the male Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
qualified by law to vote in town affairs to meet at the meeting house in said
town on Monday the 30th day of Nov^r Instant at one o'clock in the
afternoon on said day then and there to act on the following Article (viz)

1st To choose a Moderator.

2^d To see if the town will take any measures for the purpose of suppress-
ing Intemperance to do or act any way on this article as the town shall
think best when met

And you are required to serve this warrant by posting up a copy
thereof at the Public Meetinghouse in said town two Sabbaths at least
before the time set for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make due returne of this warrant with
your doings thereon to ourselves before the time set for holding
said meeting. Given under our hands and seal at Sudbury this
20th day of Nov^r A.D. 1829.
