Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified and warned all the male inhabitants of said town qualified as there is expressed to meet at time and place and for the purposes therein expressed

At a legal Town meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 1st day of March AD 1830. Then proceeded upon the business of said day by reading the afore going Warrant and took up the 1st Article And made chair of Mr John Hunt for Moderator, then proceeded and made chair of the following named persons for Town officers (viz) Abel Wheeler, Town Clerk, and was qualified in open town meeting by just votes. Selectmen. Voted to have the number of those the present year and chose—

1st Christopher G. Lutton

2nd Nahum Thompson

3rd Asa Jones then Mr Jones came forward and asked to be excused from serving as one of the selectmen being hurt to vote it passed in the negative then Mr Jones excused himself.

Then Chase Buckley Howe came forward and declined the office of selectman.

then proceeded and made chair of Martin Brown in his stead so Mr Brown stands as the 3rd selectman
