- 2.^d Article. granted the sum of one thousand Dollars for the repairs of the Highways the present year and voted to allow the same price for Labour for man or oxen &c as was the last year. the Voted to grant the sum of two hundred Dollars more in addition to the one thousand Dollars making in the whole the sum of
- \$ 1200
- 3.^d Article. granted for the winter schools the sum of \$375 granted for wood for said schools the sum of --- \$ 45 Then voted that the above named sums of money be equally divided among the five school Districts
- 4.th Article granted for the summer schools the sum of \$200 and to be equally divided among the five school Districts
- 5.th Article. passed in the negative
- 6.th Article. Voted that the overseers of the Poor be directed to let out the ^{Poor} of said town to the least bidder
- 7.th Article. put over to April meeting then to be acted upon
- 8.th ^{Article} Voted to choose a committee of three Persons as expressed in said Article and chose Capt. William Rice Capt. William Brigham and Capt. Israel Haynes for said committee
- 9.th Article. put over to April Meeting
- 10.th Article. indifferently postponed
- 11.th Article. indifferently postponed
- 12.th Article put over to April meeting
- 13.th Article Voted that all the money now in the Treasury hands not otherwise appropriated be appropriated for the Sutes at Law now pending against said town
- Then Voted to dissolve this town meeting
