

April Anno Domini 1830

At a Town Meeting legally held in Sudbury on Monday the fifth day of April AD 1830 it being the first Monday of said month. proceeded upon the business of said day by bringing in their votes to the Selectmen for Governor and Lieut. Governor, and for five Senators and Deacons as the warrant of said meeting has directed. And were for the following named persons (viz)

His Excellency Levi Lincoln seventy one votes

For Governor Hon Marcus Morton twenty three votes
Nathan Willes one vote
John Hunt one vote

For Lieut. Governor His Honour Thomas L Winthrop fifty eight votes
Hon Nathan Willes sixteen votes
Marcus Morton one vote

For Senators Silley Smith one vote
Hon Thomas J Goodwin fifty eight votes
John Lock forty six votes
Asahel Stearns forty six votes
James Winship fifty eight votes
Benj. F. Barnum twenty nine votes
James Lewis thirty four votes
L M Parker twenty two votes
M M Butler twenty two votes
John Wade thirteen votes
William Parmenter twelve votes
James Kufel ten votes

Then the town by their vote dissolved this meeting
