You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male Inhabitants
of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs
and also all those that are qualified to vote in Parish affairs to meet at
the Meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the fifth day of
April next at three O'clock in the afternoon then and there to
act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To Chose a Moderator.
- 2^d To fill all the Vacancies in the Town Officers that appear to be
vacant which the Law requires to be chosen in the month of
March or April
- 3^d To bring in their Votes for some suitable Person for a County
Inspector for the County of Middlesex.
- 4th To see if the town will except of the Settlement of the Select-
men with the Town Treasurer and order the same to be
recorded
- 5th To act on the 7th, 9th and 12th Articles in the warrant
meeting last past which was referred to April meeting for
further consideration.
- 6th To see if the town will order the town Treasurer to give bonds
to the Selectmen in behalf of the town for his faithful per-
formance of that office
- 7th To see if the town will take any measures to remove the land where
the town Pound stands and the land that Walter Haynes Decided & enclosed
to the Burying ground, and remove the Pound to some other convenient place
to do or act as the town shall think best when met.
- 8th To see if the town will give liberty for Luther Goodnow, Adner Goodnow,
Silley Smith, and Levi Smith to Bury Tombs at the east side of the
Powder House.
- 9th To see if the town will appoint some suitable person or persons to take
an accurate Plan of this town as is required by a Resolue of the
Legislature of this Commonwealth passed March the 1st A.D. 1830

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by up attested copy
of this warrant at the Publick Meeting house in said town two sabbaths
at least before the time of holding said meeting

Hence of fail not and make due returne of this warrant with your doings
there of to our selves at time and place of holding said meeting

A.D. 1830.
