

April Anno Domini. 1830

At a Legal Town meeting held in Sudbury April the 5th AD 1830. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article. and made choice of John Hunt Moderator

2 Article. made choice of John Hunt Town Treasurer then voted to pass over this Article for the present and acted on the 5th Article which contains the 4th Article of March meeting And voted to adopt the same measures as it regards the collecting of Taxes this year, as has been adopted years past, then the question was asked to know if Mr. L. G. Lutton would take the collecting of Taxes the present year and he came forward and offered to take the collecting of Taxes for one and a half cent on the Dollar then Mr. Levi Smith came forward and offered to take the collecting the Taxes for one and a quarter per cent on the Dollar and provided he could have the office of Constable Then took up the 2^d Article again and made choice of Mr. Levi Smith Constable and collector of Taxes And has taken oath of office the same day as Constable

3^d Article. Voted in their votes for a County Treasurer and were for Hon John Keyes who had thirty four votes. Then Joshua Jones 2^d And one of the Highway Surveyors chosen at March meeting and asked to be excused from serving Highway Surveyor and the town excused him then made choice of Mr. Hull Goodnow in his place and was qualified after the meeting was over for said office

Then chose Mr. Moses Warner Pound keeper and he was qualified for Pound keeper after the meeting over the same day

4th Article. Voted to accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded as follows
With the subscribers settled accounts with John Hunt Treasurer of the town of Sudbury this day for the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine and find the state of the Treasury as follows viz.
