

April Anno Domini 1830.

- 5th Article containing the 12th Article of March meeting which was referred to April meeting - a motion was made and seconded to see if they would purchase a stove to be placed in the Meeting house being put to vote it passed in the affirmative. Then a motion was made and seconded to see if they would choose a committee to purchase one or two stoves to be placed in said house being put to vote it passed in the affirmative then voted to choose the same committee that was chosen to repair the Meeting house viz Silley Smith Asbur Goodman Paul Walker Levi Smith and Reuben Haynes.
- 6th Article. directed the Town Treasurer in future to give bonds to the Selectmen for the time being in behalf of the town for his faithful performance of the duties of his office
- 7th Article. the town voted to choose a committee of three persons to take into consideration the subject matter of the said Article and the expediency of purchasing a piece of land adjoining so as to make the south line of the burying ground parallel with the wall on the south line of said yard, and to make an estimate expense of the whole subject matter thereof and to report their opinion at the next May meeting Dr Thomas Stearns, Asbur Goodman Esq and Capt William Brigham were appointed for that purpose.
- 8th Article voted to give liberty for said persons named in said Article to build their tombs provided they do not interfere on the road.
- 9th Article. voted to choose the Selectmen to let out the survey of the town and the making of the plan of the same to the lowest bidder so as to comply with the requisition of said Referee into effect and carry the same into effect.

Thus the town by their vote dissolved this meeting
