2^d Article. granted to the Reverend Rufus Hunt his salary \$457.⁹⁵

3rd Article. granted for the support of the Poor the sum of - - - 850.⁰⁰

4 Article. Voted to give their Assessors one Dollar per day each
during the time they shall expend in making the Taxes and Services
as Assessors the present year

5th Article granted to pay the town Treasurer for his services the sum of 10.⁰⁰

6th Article. granted to pay the accounts allowed by the Committee on acts - 95.⁶⁵
to sundry persons which is recorded in the next page

7th Article granted to finishing paying for repairs of the Meeting house 90.⁰⁰
it being for Parish purposes - - -

8th Article. granted for contingent expenses that may accrue the sum of 150.⁰⁰

9th Article Voted to pass over this Article not to act upon it.

10 Article Voted to pass over this Article not to act upon it.

11th Article. Voted the Selectmen be directed to let out the taking care of the meeting
house ringing the Bell and digging of graves

12th Article. Voted to choose a committee of five one to each School District
for the purpose of viewing the road lately located from Israel Brown
house to the one located from the Mill Bridge to Gordners Bredes Born
and chose Martin Brown, Luther Goodnow, John Goodnow, Eddy
Fainbanks, and Daniel Puffer and to state their opinion to the town
together with Mr Browns offers whether it is best to petition the
County Commissioners for an alteration in the location at the adjournment
of this meeting
