Middlesex ss. To Levi Smith Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in said County.

Greeting

You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said town on Monday the 9th day of August next at 3 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

- 1st To elect a Moderator.
- 2^d To take such measures as the town shall think proper in making the roads located on the Petition of Sullivan Thayer and others, and on the petition of Christy & Lutton and others. And grant a suitable sum of money for the same.
- 3^d To grant money for their Soldiers who uniform and equip them selves & do Militia duty conformable to the late Law.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy thereof at the Public Meeting house in said Town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hence of fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings there on to our selves at time and place of holding said meeting.

Given under our hands and seal at Sudbury aforesaid this twenty sixth day of July AD 1830.
