

August Anno Domini 1830.

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 9th day of August A.D. 1830. proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and made choice of William Hunt Esq. Moderator

2 Article. After some time being spent in discussing the subject matter of said Article it was moved and seconded to see if the town would appoint a Committee to let out the two roads as expressed in said Article being put to vote it passed in the affirmative then the town voted to have the number of five on said Committee one to each District, then chose After Goodnow Esq. Mr John Hunt. Mr Asa Balcom, Capt. Abner Goodnow and Capt Lyman Howe. said Committee was instructed to let out said roads to the best advantage to the town and agreeable to the orders of Court and report to the town their doings there on at some future meeting.

Then the Town granted the sum of - - - - - \$64.⁰⁰
for the expense of making said roads -

3^d Article. The Town granted the sum of - - - - - \$100.⁰⁰
for the soldiers as expressed in said Article. Then the Town by their vote dissolved this meeting William Hunt Moderator
