You are hereby required in the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to and warn all the male Inhabitants of said Town to meet at the Meeting-house on Monday the sixth day of September next at 2 O'clock in the afternoon on said day there and there to act on the following Articles (viz)

1st To choose a Moderator

2^d To see if the Town will reconsider so much of their vote passed at the town meeting held in Sudbury August the 9th 1830 relation to the grant of five hundred and sixty four dollars for the purpose of making the road located on the Petitions of Sullivan Thayer and others and Christ^r of Lutton & other or revoke so much of the ^{grant} passed at said meeting, so as to comply with the contract made by the Committee with individuals in making and completing said roads to do, or act any way on this Article as the town shall think Best when met By request of Willard Maynard and others

3^d To see if the town will choose an agent or agents, to oppose the road Petitioned for by Asher Goodnow and others, reference to the order of notice being had to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copy thereof at the public meeting house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

Here of fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings there on to our selves at time and place of holding said meeting
