At a legal town meeting held in Sudbury September the 6th A.D. 1830
proceeded upon the business of said day by taking up the 1st Article and
made choice of Mr. John Hunt Moderator.

2^d Article, it was moved and seconded to pass over this Article being put to vote it
passed in the negative. Then it was moved and seconded to revoke or reconsider
so much of the vote passed at the town meeting held at Sudbury the 7th day
of August last passed to take off of the grant of money made at said meeting
the sum of \$168.00 being put to vote it passed in the affirmative.

3^d Article, it was moved and seconded to choose an agent to wait on the county
commissioners to advocate the road Petitioners for by Asher Goodnow
and others it being put to vote it passed in the affirmative and made
choice of Mr. Peabody Moore for that purpose. Then the town by
their vote dissolved this meeting John Hunt Moderator

Massachusetts to notify and warn all the male inhabitants of said
town qualified to vote in the choice of a Representative to the General Court
of this Commonwealth to meet at the Meeting house in said town on
Monday the 1st day of November next it being the first Monday
of said month at 1 O'clock in afternoon on said day then and there
to bring in their votes to the selectmen for a Representative of the
People of said Commonwealth in the Congress of the United States for
the Middlesex district.

And you are ~~required~~ to serve this warrant by posting up
attested copy thereof at the public Meeting house two Sabbaths
at least before the time set for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your
doings thereon to our selves at time and place of holding said meeting

October A.D. 1830
